



WHEREAS, emergency public health declarations exist at the federal, state and county levels and gatherings of more than 10 people have been restricted; and


WHEREAS, the Garland County Quorum Court meeting scheduled at 6 p.m., April 13, 2020, has potential to bring greater numbers of people together than currently recommended; and

WHEREAS, this order is issued pursuant to Amendment 55 of the Arkansas Constitution; other relevant statutory authority; and Ark. Code Ann. 14-14-904(a)(iii)(B)(2); and,

WHEREAS, this order is issued in consideration of the Garland County Disaster Emergency Proclamation signed on March 16, 2020 by Garland County Judge Darryl Mahoney, as authorized by Ark. Code Ann. 12-75-103 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby order that the meeting of the Garland County, Quorum Court that is scheduled at 6 p.m., April 13, 2020 shall be postponed to 5:45 p.m., May 11, 2020. The regularly scheduled meeting of the Garland County Quorum Court set for 6 p.m., May 11, 2020 shall be conducted as scheduled.
