Ordinance Committee Meeting
Minutes
January 14, 2019

Acting Chairman McGrew called the meeting to order and introduced Ordinance O-19-01, an ordinance setting rules of procedure for Garland County Quorum Court. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Reagan and seconded by Justice Braziel. Acting Chairman McGrew asked for questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.

Acting Chairman McGrew introduced Ordinance O-19-02, an ordinance to amend the 2019 Budget Ordinance O-18-56, and appropriate funds to the Assessor's and County Road Budgets. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Dixon. Acting Chairman McGrew asked for questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.


Acting Chairman McGrew introduced Ordinance O-19-03, an ordinance to amend the 2019 Budget Ordinance O-18-56, anticipate revenues and appropriate funds in various grant budgets. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Hunter. Acting Chairman McGrew asked for questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.

Acting Chairman McGrew introduced Ordinance O-19-04, an ordinance to amend the 2018 Garland County budget Ordinance O-17-55 and to appropriate funds to the Special Projects budget to correct Ordinance O-18-55. Section 10 of Ordinance O-18-55 authorized the transfer of \$30,941 from the Ouachita Memorial Hospital Sale Fund to the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant and the 4th whereas requested the appropriation. However, the ordinance did not include a section to instruct the appropriation of \$30,941 in the OMH Sale Fund. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Reagan and seconded by Justice Braziel. Acting Chairman McGrew asked for questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.

Acting Chairman McGrew introduced Ordinance O-19-05, an ordinance to amend the 2019 Budget Ordinance O-18-56, anticipate revenues and appropriate funds in various budgets in the Sheriff's Office. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Reagan. Acting Chairman McGrew asked for questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.
