Ordinance Committee Meeting
Minutes
April 8, 2019

Members Present: Vice Chairman McGrew, Justice Dixon, Young, Hunter, Braziel, and Reagan
Members Absent: Chairman Owen
Also Present: Citizens, Elected Officials, Staff, and Media

Vice Chairman McGrew called the meeting to order and introduced Resolution R-19-04, a resolution confirming the reappointment to the Garland County Waterworks and Sewer Facilities Board (Hot Springs Village). A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Young. Vice Chairman McGrew asked for questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.

Vice Chairman McGrew introduced Ordinance O-19-15, an ordinance amending ordinance O-16-54 establishing a credit card reimbursement and travel policy for Garland County Government. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel, seconded by Justice Young. Vice Chairman McGrew asked for questions or discussion, Judge Mahoney explained the per diem rate changes, with nothing further the motion passed without opposition.

Vice Chairman McGrew introduced Ordinance O-19-16, an ordinance to amend the 2019 Garland County budget Ordinance O-18-56 and to appropriate funds in various budgets. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Reagan and seconded by Justice Braziel. Vice Chairman McGrew asked for questions or discussion, Judge Mahoney explained that this was a grant ordinance, with nothing further the motion passed without opposition.

Vice Chairman McGrew introduced Ordinance O-19-17, an ordinance to amend the 2019 Budget Ordinance O-18-56, and to appropriate funds in the Prosecuting Attorney's Budget. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Reagan and seconded by Justice Young. Vice Chairman McGrew asked for questions or discussion, Justice Anderson explained the pay raise was approved in Human Resources, with nothing further the motion passed without opposition.
