Members Present in the Zoom virtual meeting: Chairman Owen, Vice-Chairman McGrew, Justices Reagan, Young, Dixon, Hunter, and Braziel

Chairman Owen called the meeting to order and introduced Resolution R-20-18, a resolution authorizing the County Judge to apply for an Arkansas Administrative Office of the Courts Security Grant. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Young and seconded by Justice Dixon. Chairman Owen asked Judge Mahoney if he would like to explain the grant. Judge Mahoney explained that this grant would be used to purchase personal protection equipment for the District and Circuit Court. With nothing further, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Resolution R-20-19, a resolution authorizing the County Judge to apply for a Department of Justice (DOJ) Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Grant. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Dixon and seconded by Justice Braziel. Chairman Owen asked Judge Mahoney if he would like to explain the grant. Judge Mahoney explained that this grant would be used for overtime pay of law enforcement and to purchase personal protection equipment. With nothing further, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Resolution R-20-20, a resolution authorizing the County Judge to apply for a Blue & You Foundation, COVID-19 Rapid Relief Grant. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Young and seconded by Justice Braziel. Chairman Owen asked Judge Mahoney if he would like to explain the grant. Judge Mahoney explained that this grant would be used to purchase test kits. With nothing further, the motion passed without opposition.


Chairman Owen introduced Resolution R-20-21, Consideration of a resolution authorizing the County Judge to apply for a Bulletproof Vest 50% matching to be used for the Circuit Court Bailiffs. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Dixon. Chairman Owen asked Judge Mahoney to explain what the grant would be used. Judge Mahoney indicated it would be used to purchase vests for the Bailiffs. With nothing further, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-20-13, an ordinance to amend the 2020 Budget Ordinance O-19-54, to anticipate revenue, appropriate and transfer funds in various budgets. Chairman Owen asked Judge Mahoney to explain the need. Judge Mahoney explained that the requests were for several grants. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Reagan and seconded by Justice Dixon. With nothing further, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-20-14, an ordinance to amend the **2020** Budget Ordinance O-19-54, to anticipate revenue and to appropriate and un-appropriate expenditures in various budgets, due to the COVID-19 Crisis. Chairman Owen explained the need. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Hunter. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, and with none the motion passed without opposition.
