

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. O-19-13

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

“AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019 GARLAND COUNTY BUDGET ORDINANCE O-18-56; ANTICIPATE REVENUES; TO APPROPRIATE/TRANSFER FUNDS THEREFORE TO THE FINANCE AND GENERAL SERVICES BUDGETS; AND, FOR OTHER PURPOSES.”

WHEREAS, the County Judge requested an appropriation for \$4,415.00 to the Finance Budget for a salary increase to the Human Resources Director position (PCN: 1000.0113.1003); and,

WHEREAS, the County Judge requested an appropriation/transfer for \$4,415.00 to the General Services Budget to fund the above increase; and,

WHEREAS, the Human Resources and Finance Committees previously met and approved this request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the sum of \$4,415.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Finance Budget in the following manner:

SECTION 2. That Anticipated Revenues for the General Fund are increased by \$4,415.00, and the Quorum Court may appropriate 100% of these revenues to the General Services Budget.



SECTION 3. That the sum mentioned in Section 1 has no effect on the 2018 General Fund Anticipated Revenues.


SECTION 4. That the sum mentioned in Section 1 represents an increase of \$4,415.00 to the Finance Budget.

SECTION 5. That the sum mentioned in Section 2 represents an increase of \$4,415.00 to the General Fund Anticipated Revenues.


SECTION 6. That the sum mentioned in Section 2 represents an increase of \$4,415.00 to the General Services Budget.
