

ORDINANCE NO. O-19-39

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS; AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

“AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE O-10-62, PERTAINING TO THE SERVICE FEES CHARGED FOR THE COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE IN GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS; AND FOR THEIR PURPOSES.”

WHEREAS, Ordinance O-10-62, as amended by O-96-36, O-97-10, O-97-11, O-98-54, O-99-27, O-01-14, O-02-48, O-05-08 have previously established a solid waste collection system; and, Ordinance O-10-62, O-97-52, O-98-54, O-99-23, O-05-48, O-06-35, have previously established fees for collection of solid waste in Garland County, Arkansas; and,

WHEREAS, these ordinances require the Garland County Quorum Court to establish the service fees to be charged for the services to be provided therein; and,

WHEREAS, the County Judge requests the annual fee schedule be adjusted to include the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for Class 1 hauling each year; and,

WHEREAS, the Environmental Services, Public Works, and Buildings Committee and the Finance Committee previously met and recommended the Solid Waste and Recycling Service Fees that are attached to this ordinance and marked as Exhibit “A” be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The Garland County Solid Waste and Recycling Service Fees, which are attached to this ordinance and marked as Exhibit “A”: are hereby adopted.


SECTION 2: An annual adjustment for CPI to the Class 1 Waste hauling shall be amended to the fee schedule annually.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY, If any portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or application of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end, the provision of this Ordinance is declared to be severable.


SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall be codified in the Garland County Code of Ordinances and the sections may be renumbered and relettered to accomplish such intention.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is necessary for the timely and orderly conduct of public business. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
