BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

“A RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO APPLY FOR AN ARKANSAS HISTORIC PRESERVATION PROGRAM (AHPP) GRANT ON BEHALF OF GARLAND COUNTY.”

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court has determined that the County Judge meets eligibility requirements necessary to apply for an AHPP grant; and,


WHEREAS, the County Judge presented plans to replace the terra cotta on several sections of the courthouse and repair the interior damage to the Division I courtroom caused from an exterior water infiltration problem discovered when the upper terra cotta units were replaced; and,

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court recognizes the need for the AHPP grant, concurs in its importance, and supports the County Judge in his efforts to proceed with the same; and,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the County Judge is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the AHPP grant administrator for the purpose of securing grant funds in the amount of \$346,117.00 to aid and assist in executing the proposed program described herein and that the County Judge is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same program.
