

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. O-17-25

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

“AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2017 GARLAND COUNTY BUDGET ORDINANCE O-16-95; AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS THEREFORE TO THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY BUDGET; AND, FOR OTHER PURPOSES.”

WHEREAS, previously funds were transferred to provide for grant expenses for the (VOCA) Victims of Crime Act Grant Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney received reimbursements from the State of Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration for \$56,539.60 and has requested an appropriation/transfer to reimburse the OMH Sale Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney has requested an appropriation/transfer of \$19,254.65 from the County General Fund to reimburse the OMH Sale Fund for the county match; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has previously met and approved this request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Anticipated Revenues for the (VOCA) Victims of Crime Grant Fund are \$56,539.60 and the Quorum Court may appropriate up to 100% of these Anticipated Revenues. The sum of \$56,539.60 is hereby appropriated from the (VOCA) Victims of Crime Act Grant Fund to the Prosecuting Attorney Budget in the following manner.

SECTION 2. That the sum of \$19,254.65 is hereby appropriated from the County General Fund to the Prosecuting Attorney Budget in the following manner:

SECTION 3. That the sum mentioned in Section 1 represents an increase of \$56,539.60 to the 2017 Prosecuting Attorney Budget in the (VOCA) Victims of Crime Act Grant Fund.

SECTION 4. That the sum mentioned in Section 1 represents an increase of \$56,539.60 to the 2017 (VOCA) Victims of Crime Act Grant Fund Anticipated Revenues.

SECTION 5. That the sum mentioned in Section 2 represents an increase of \$19,254.65 to the 2017 Prosecuting Attorney Budget in the General Fund.


SECTION 6. That the sum mentioned in Section 1 has no effect on the 2017 General Fund Anticipated Revenue.

SECTION 7. That the sum mentioned in Sections 1 and 2 represents an increase of \$75,794.25 to the 2017 OMH Sale Fund Anticipated Revenues.

SECTION 8. That the County Treasurer and the County Judge are hereby authorized to execute completion of transfers as follows:
