

RESOLUTION NO. R-21-10

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

“A RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS, AUTHORIZING THE GARLAND COUNTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO APPLY FOR A FY 2021-2022 VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT (VOCA), VICTIMS ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM TOTALING \$184,374.71, MATCHING GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY’S OFFICE.”

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court has determined that the Prosecuting Attorney meets the eligibility requirements necessary to apply for a VOCA grant; and,


WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney has presented plans to provide advocacy and support to victims of domestic violence, endangering the welfare of a minor, and human trafficking cases; and,

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court recognizes the need for the VOCA grant, concurs in its importance, and supports the Prosecuting Attorney in her efforts to proceed with the same; and,

WHEREAS, the grant will require a 20% local match of \$36,869.87, and the Quorum Court hereby expresses its support to provide the local matching funds.

SECTION 1. That the Prosecuting Attorney is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration, Office of Intergovernmental Services for the purpose of securing federal grant funds in the amount of \$147,504.84 to aid and assist the Prosecuting Attorney in executing the proposed programs described herein and that the County Judge and the Prosecuting Attorney are further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same purpose.
