BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

“A RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS, AUTHORIZING THE GARLAND COUNTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO APPLY FOR A MATCHING GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY’S OFFICE.”

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court has determined that the Prosecuting Attorney meets the eligibility requirements necessary to apply for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program; and,


WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney has presented plans to fund partially fund two Drug Task Force positions, and pay for professional services such as rent, vehicle leases and pay for an accountant; and,


WHEREAS, the Quorum Court recognizes the need for the positions and professional services, concurs its importance, and supports the Prosecuting Attorney in her efforts to proceed with the same; and,


WHEREAS, the grant will require a 20 % local match of \$11,709.49 for the requested federal funds, and the Quorum Court hereby expresses its support to provide the local matching fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the Prosecuting Attorney is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Bureau of Justice Assistance for the purpose of securing federal and state grant funds for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program in the amount of \$86,499.02 to aid and assist the Prosecuting Attorney’s Office in partially funding two positions and paying for the professional services described herein and that the County Judge and the Prosecuting Attorney are further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same positions and services.
