BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

“A RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS AUTHORIZING THE GARLAND COUNTY SHERIFF TO APPLY FOR A \$24,562.00 OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) ON BEHALF OF THE SHERIFF’S OFFICE.”

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court has determined that the Sheriff meets the eligibility requirements necessary to apply for the JAG Program; and,

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has presented plans to purchase training software and a Simulator, which will allow deputies to train in real-world scenarios; and,

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court recognizes the need for the training software and simulator, concurs its importance, and supports the Sheriff in his efforts to proceed with the same; and,

WHEREAS, the grant requires no local match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the Sheriff is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Office of Justice Assistance for the purpose of securing federal and state grant funds for the JAG Program in the amount of \$24,562.00 to aid and assist the Sheriff’s Office executing the proposed project described herein and that the County Judge and the Sheriff are further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same program.
