BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS; A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

**"A RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS PROCLAIMING MARCH 29<sup>TH</sup> AS VIETNAM VETERAN'S DAY."**

**WHEREAS,** Vietnam Veterans Day commemorates the sacrifice of Vietnam Veterans and their families and is part of a national effort to recognize the men and women who were denied a proper welcome upon returning home more than 40 years ago; and,

**WHEREAS,** on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of March in 1973, the last combat troops were withdrawn from Vietnam and the last prisoners of war held in North Vietnam arrived on American soil. It is also the date President Nixon chose for the first Vietnam Veterans Day in 1974; and,

**WHEREAS,** in celebration of this special occasion, the Vietnam Veterans should be commended for their dedication and faithful service to God, Country and to the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS;**

**SECTION 1.** Garland County, Arkansas will join with fellow citizens across the United States in recognizing and participating in this special observance on March 29<sup>th</sup> as Vietnam Veterans Day.
