

RESOLUTION NO. R-19-15

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

“A RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS, AUTHORIZING THE GARLAND COUNTY JUDGE TO APPLY FOR A MATCHING GRANT TO REPAIR AND RESURFACE A PORTION OF BLACKSNAKE ROAD.”

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court has determined that the County Judge and the National Park Service meet the eligibility requirements necessary to apply for a Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) grant; and

WHEREAS, the County Judge has presented plans to repair and resurface a 1.7-mile section of Blacksnake Road that is owned by the National Park Service and maintained by Garland County; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court recognizes the need to repair and resurface the 1.7-mile section of Blacksnake Road, concurs in its importance, and supports the County Judge and the National Park Service in their efforts to proceed with the same; and

WHEREAS, the grant will require a local match of 20 percent and The National Park Service has pledged to provide the matching funds and has provided proof that it has \$55,000 available to be applied as the matching funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE COUNTY JUDGE IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO APPLY FOR THE GRANT DESCRIBED HEREIN;

SECTION 1. That the County Judge is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Office of Federal Lands Highway, Federal Highway Administration for the purpose of securing federal grant funds in the amount of \$220,000 to aid and assist the County and the National Park Service in executing the proposed project described herein and that the County Judge is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same purpose.




