
WHEREAS, the Quorum Court has determined that the County Sheriff meets the eligibility requirements necessary to apply for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program; and,

WHEREAS, the County Sheriff has presented plans to purchase equipment for investigators to preserve crime scenes, mobile data terminals and radar units for deputies in the field; and,


WHEREAS, the Quorum Court recognizes the need for the crime scene equipment, mobile data terminals and radar units, concurs in its importance, and supports the County Sheriff in his efforts to proceed with the same; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS:


SECTION 1. That the County Sheriff is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Bureau of Justice Assistance for the purpose of securing federal grant funds for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program in the amount of \$25,189.00 to aid and assist the Sheriff’s Office in purchasing the proposed crime scene equipment, mobile data terminals and radar units described herein and that the County Judge and the County Sheriff are further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same equipment.
