**“A RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS, AUTHORIZING THE GARLAND COUNTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO APPLY FOR A GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE DRUG TASK FORCE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Garland County Quorum Court has determined that the Prosecuting Attorney’s Office – Drug Task Force meets eligibility requirements necessary to apply for a Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Grant; and,


**WHEREAS**, the Prosecuting Attorney has presented plans to utilize Alheim Body-worn kits for gathering information to prosecute cases, and attend specialized officer training conferences; and,


**WHEREAS**, the Quorum Court of Garland County recognizes the need for the Alheim Body-worn kits and specialized officer training conferences, concurs its importance, and supports the Prosecuting Attorney’s Office in its efforts to proceed with the same; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Garland County Prosecuting Attorney is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the State of Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration, Office of Intergovernmental Services for the purpose of securing state grant funds in the amount of \$24,800.00 to aid and assist the Prosecuting Attorney’s Office - Drug Task Force in executing the proposed project described herein and that the Garland County Judge is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same program.
